- Resources for literacy and special needs teaching
- Fiction for young adults, particularly quick reads

- Submit as a Word document (.doc not .docx)
- Send first three chapters only (unless total word count is 200 or less.)
- Provide a short synopsis of the story or series.
- If your submission is intended to be part of a series, include details of the series and any proposed support material.
- Indicate the reading age and the interest age of your work.
- Give an estimate of the final word count.
- It is not necessary to provide artwork with your submission.
- Include a brief summary of your writing career.
