

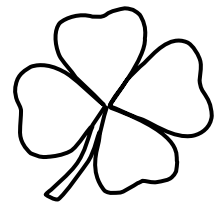
St. Patrick's Day Logic Puzzle

2. Fiona found more than Ryan, but fewer than Ling.
3. Ryan found twice as many as Eileen.
